India is commemorating the 150th birth anniversary of its great leader Mahatma Gandhi. Gandhi was a visionary who dreamt of a society free of caste, religious, economic and gender prejudices and his messages indeed transcend time and space. It is an occasion to remember them and translate them in our everyday practice.

Social Work draws heavily from Gandhian values and principles. It is time to revisit and re-emphasise these principles. Accordingly, Department of Social Work, University of Delhi is holding a series of international webinars on Gandhian Thoughts and Social Work Practice during the months of September-October 2020. Faculties, researchers and students of the Departments of Social Work from India and abroad, members of various NGOs and all those interested in the theme are invited to participate in these events.

Dr Mark Lindley, born in 1937 in Washington DC, is the Professor of Eminence at Mahatma Gandhi Mission University in Aurangabad. He was formerly the University Chair Professor at the University of Hyderabad's School of Economics, and has served as a visiting professor at a number of other universities in India and abroad. He has written incisively on such topics as Gandhi's views on health, his place in the history of modern crowd-psychology, and his religious eclecticism.
